ETHIOPIA. Hunting safaris in Ethiopia offer a rare and exclusive experience, distinct from more typical African hunting destinations. Situated in the Horn of Africa, Ethiopia's diverse geography—ranging from towering highlands to savannas and arid deserts—creates a unique backdrop for pursuing some of the continent's most elusive and endemic game species. Ethiopia's hunting is smaller, less accessible, and caters to a niche group of dedicated hunters seeking trophies found nowhere else. These safaris are typically rugged, physically demanding, and steeped in adventure. Quotas are very limited and hunts are conducted on vast concessions, often spanning mountains like the Bale mountain range down to the low plains like the Omo Valley. Accommodations are comfortable tented camps with basic amenities. Spot-and-stalk or walk-and-stalk are the only way to hunt. The season runs year-round, though October to June is preferred to avoid the rainy months of July to September. These mountain hunts require stamina and precision, with shots typically under 200 yards in thick forests, though longer cross-canyon shots (up to 350 yards) can occur. Lowland hunts offer more open terrain but test endurance in hotter climates.
